

Advertising Space – Spanish Night Program

Here is an easy way you can help support our kids, support our school and support the Friends of the Museum School!

This year we are selling advertising space in the program for our fabulous *Spanish Night* fundraiser at the Prado, on February 28th, 2010. *You can help by either purchasing ad space for your own business, sending a message to a special teacher, or by asking a local business to purchase an ad.* The process is very simple!

The program will be 8 inches by 8 inches, professionally designed and printed in black and white. A full-page ad will cost just \$75 and a half-page ad will be only \$50. It is a great opportunity for a business to have a captive audience pay attention to their direct message, or perhaps you would like to send a message to your child or your child's teacher.

All our designer will need is a 300dpi, black and white image at 100% of the ad size (see below) in either a TIF, JPG or EPS format.

Full Page Size = 7.5" x 7.5"

Half Page Size = 7.5" wide x 3.625" (3 5/8") high

IF, you would just like to send a message and the above information does not mean anything to you, do not despair - *you are not alone!* Simply write your message in the space below in very clear handwriting and our designer will type it up and make it look nice for you.

Checks should be made out to the Friends of the Museum School and images should be emailed to museumschoolphil@gmail.com by January 31, 2010. A confirmation email will be sent to the business owner once we receive the image, and a receipt will be sent once we receive payment.
